The date has been set for Sunday, September 17th from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The event will be open to anyone in the community who wishes to compete. Contestants will provide their own firearm, ammunition, eye & ear protection. Competition will be based on License To Carry Qualification Criteria with the same point system and firearms. Orientations will be available for those who wish to become members of SAGC. Trophies sponsored by local businesses will

RANGE PLAN AMENDED

The decision was made and approved by majority vote at the March 28, 2017 SAGC meeting to amend the original plan for the third precision rifle bay and the area between the West long berm and the easement road. These changes are not immediate, but will be instituted as we progress to that area. The 100 yard bay and intermediate berms will remain at the south end with a parking area immediately behind this area. The remainder of the bay will include pistol bays both narrow and wider ones for individuals, and LTC classes.

The short berms that are now located west of the long berm and are open to the easement road will be removed. Excess dirt will be used to make the long berm taller. As we progress there will be a retention pond in the area near the current gate that has been holding water. This will solve the drainage issues for that area that gathers water from north, south, and west drainage.

The Range Committee will investigate and make suggestions regarding product(s) to use for side berms that will allow more individual bays than are possible with dirt berms.

BULLDOZER AND OLDEST FRONT END LOADER

These items have been sold for a total of \$3,000.00

which includes removing them from the range.

Neither are operational at this point and will not be replaced.

The money will be placed in the Operations Account.
