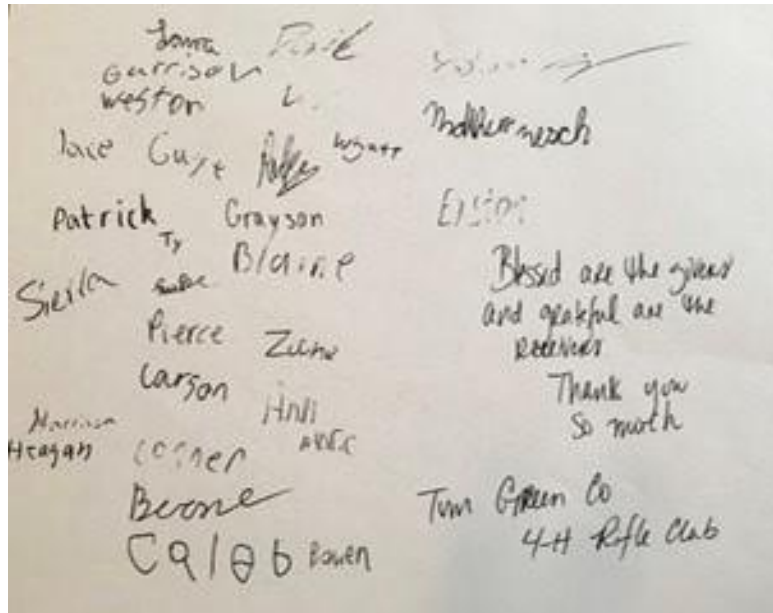

Need some ammo? You can win a \$25 Outdoorsman gift card by attending a monthly Membership meeting. Good luck and see you on the 28th.

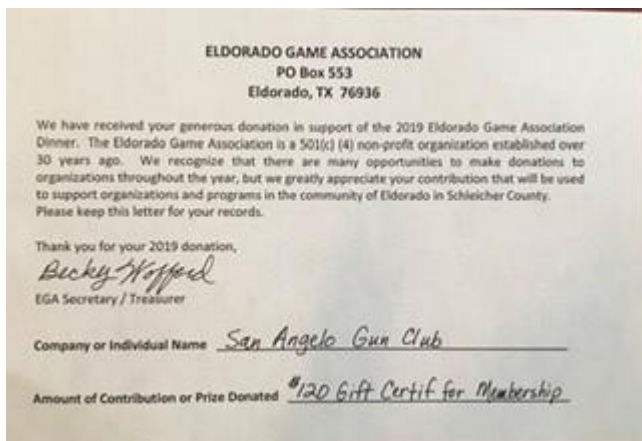
Your Member ID card has your **renewal** date. Renew online at any time by visiting the SAGC website.
