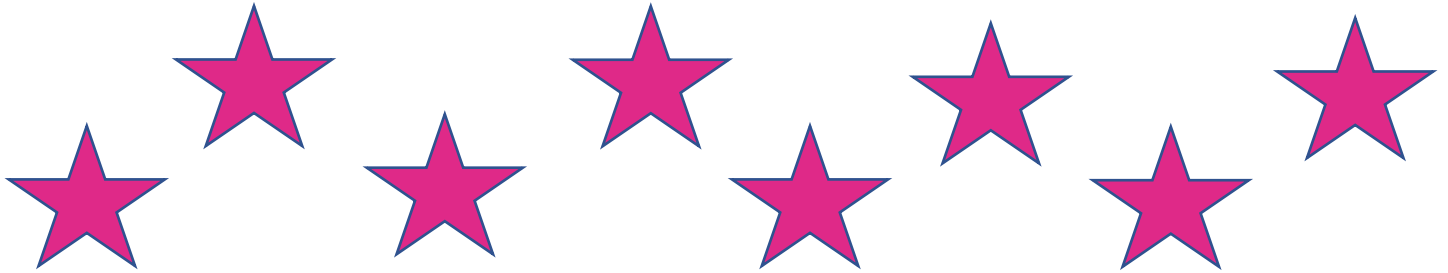
# DAUGHTERS
