We remember our President, Janette Story



Janette Story passed away after a brief illness on November 14, 2017. She had served as our President since August 2016 and previously held the title of Treasurer. As President, she was instrumental in organizing and leading Officers, volunteers, and members of the community in growing and improving the Club in many ways. She had a vision for the future of the Club and worked tirelessly to set us all on the path to complete this.

She found her passion for shooting in about 2008 after her husband, Johnny, passed away. A year later, she joined the San Angelo Gun Club, continued to improve her shooting skills to the point of becoming a licensed NRA instructor as well as taking Range Safety Officer classes. Janette continued to improve her shooting skills by participating in competitive shoots and twice attending the renowned Clint Smith's Thunder Ranch classes. In addition to shooting, she became skilled in self defense and took many classes to ensure she was able to protect herself. Janette grew from an occasional hunter as a young girl out with her Dad to an expert marksman and licensed instructor. Along the way, she met and made many new friends and became a frequent face at the Club, becoming more involved with each year.

She combined her love of teaching children with shooting and founded Daughters at the Range, an LLC organization designed to teach young girls about guns and shooting. This organization has thrived and grown since its inception in 2013. This event has allowed hundreds of young girls to learn about guns and experience shooting a .22, many for the first time. The positive effects this event may have on the girls' lives will never be known.
