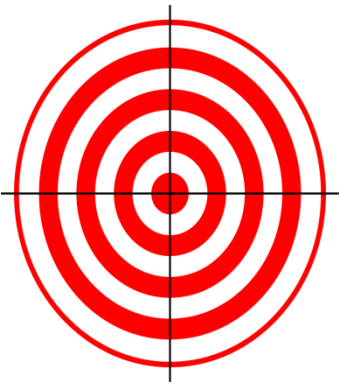

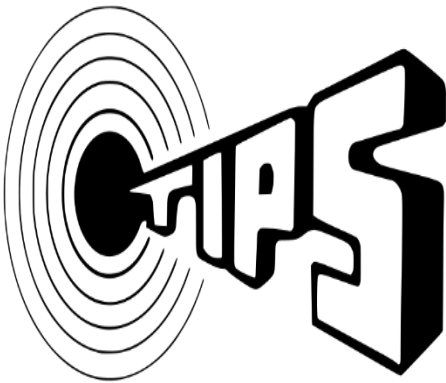
**Please get involved, bring ideas and suggestions, and be aware of the current and future changes of YOUR club. Our continued success depends on the involvement of you, the Members.**
